Mr. George B. McCiellan is as inaccurate about the Flemish language as he usually is about other things. The Flemish names for Bruxelles, Liege, and Louvain, which he gives, (namely, Brussel, Lowen, and Luttich,) are pure German. In Flemish those cities are called Brussel, (without the diaeresis,) Leuven, and Luik.
